On the 15 October 2024 we will be publishing our CACoP Code Administrator Led Survey.

This year, the CACoP Forum are running the CACoP (Code Administrators Code of Practice) survey, as requested by Ofgem. The survey provides an opportunity to assess the performance of the different Code Administrators. This did not go ahead last year due to Energy Code Reform, so we are happy that it has been given the go ahead again, as we are keen to get your feedback.

The survey can be found on the CACoP website from the 15 October 2024 and should be completed once per individual code.

P478 Implementation of MHHS Arrangement

Update

On September 2024, Ofgem raised Modification Proposal P478 'Implementation of Market-wide Half Hourly Settlement (MHHS) Arrangements'.

This Modification proposes changes to the BSC to enable Market-Wide Half-Hourly Settlement (MHHS) arrangements facilitating Ofgem's Target Operating Model (TOM)

This Modification will ensure the appropriate obligations, processes, and provisions for the new MHHS arrangements are inputted to the BSC.

Update

The workgroup members have been conducting open discussions and collaborating to refine the solution, discuss Workgroup Alternative Requests, and review draft legal text.

These Workgroup Consultations gave the members and other industry participants an opportunity to actively contribute to these workgroup deliberations by providing additional feedback and perspectives.
